Student Conduct Expectations

The purpose of these expectations is to be proactive in informing students and their parents/guardians of the appropriate conduct needed to insure that each student is protected and provided a quality environment for ministry while on the Church campus or Church sponsored events.

Conduct Expectations for Special Events

Students are expected to:

1. To have fun, be friendly, fellowship, focus on their faith and follow adult leadership.
2. To not leave the grounds during the event without the knowledge and permission of adult leadership and to not drive to or from an event without the written authorization from a parent or guardian and the Youth leader.
3. To dress in a modest way that reflects Christian values and does not draw undue attention to physical features (No short skirts/shorts, short midriff clothing, tank tops, tight or revealing clothing, inappropriate slogans, sayings, or pictures). Girls are expected to wear one-piece or full covering "tankini" swimsuits. Guys are expected to not wear Speedos.
4. To refrain from PDA, Personal Displays of Affection, including holding hands, hugging, kissing, sitting in each other's laps, and anything else adult leadership deems PDA.
5. To abstain from bringing laser pointers, watching inappropriate TV/videos, listening to inappropriate music, and taking inappropriate pictures.
6. To refrain from practical jokes and pranks during events. (Ex. Fireworks, shaving cream, water fights, etc.)
7. To show up on time and to participate with the group unless exception is approved by an adult leader.
8. To abstain from tobacco, drugs, alcohol, and weapons while on the church campus or church sponsored event.
9. To not enter the rooms or "Hang Around" the rooms of members of the opposite sex.
10. To remain in rooms, have lights off, and sleep when instructed by the event schedule.
11. To be financially responsible for additional room charges and any accidental or intentional damage to the facilities.
